

Tasting Notes

The color is dark with a nose of good complexity. The wine is supple, charming, with a pretty palette of spicy aromas thanks to an enchanting merlot, all in suavity

Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Château Troplong Mondot , 1 ha with the same exposure as Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.
