Tasting Notes



Finely spiced nose with notes of very ripe red fruits. Ample and structured mouth on beautiful chocolate tannins and fruits so intensely concentrated. Elegance when you.

Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Castle Troplong Mondot , 1 ha with the same exposure as the Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.
