Density : 6500 vines per hectare  
Production : 24 000 btls  
Yield : 37,50hl/ha



### Blending

90% Merlot  
10% Cabernet Sauvignon

### Maturing

70% oak barrels  
30% vat wine.

### Harvest time

5-6 october/18 october.

### Tasting Notes



An explosion of very fresh, very red fruits. A tasty mouth which presents a fine acidity coated by soft and discreet tannins.

*Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Castle Troplong Mondot , 1 ha with the same exposure as the Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.*
