Tasting Notes



Beautiful garnet color. On the nose, aromas of beautifully ripen black fruits and cocoa. Delicately balanced mouth whole in fruits with velvety tannins and always elegance.

Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Castle Troplong Mondot, 1 ha with the same exposure as the Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.
