

Tasting Notes



Dark color, pretty nose of blackberry and red cherries. The wine is supple, finely wooded, charming, elegant, of a good length, the finish nicely spiced, all on a background of freshness.

Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Castle Troplong Mondot , 1 ha with the same exposure as the Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.
