A very beautiful wine, delicious in its black and blue blueberry fruit, both juicy and crunchy and its notes of green pepper and fresh humus which add to its complexity. Between a real maturity of fruit and these green notes which confirm its freshness, on a ripe background of velvety tannins, we expect a very bright future for this wine
