Château Saint Julian stands in the heart of the Entre-Deux-Mers region, a step away from the Benedictine Abbey of La Sauve Majeure. With more structure than its younger brother Château Virecourt Conté, Château Saint Julian is consistently rich and enticing with its expressive black fruit aromas.

With its dark color, this wine shows a nice and elegant nose of red fruits. It is concentrated with fine tannins dress, a nice concentration all very elegant. It offers a beautiful persistence and freshness in the final.

New facilities with temperature control, a half barrel cellar buried to maintain a constant humidity and a local water treatment for the waste were built in 2006 to meet the highest standards to produce and age a Grand Bordeaux worthy of its name..
