An explosion of very fresh, very red fruits. A tasty mouth which presents a fine acidity coated by soft and discreet tannins.

Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Castle Troplong Mondot, 1 ha with the same exposure as the Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.
