Tasting Notes



The nose is open and frank with notes of very dark choco-late. The wine is seductive, exhilarating the roundness of the merlot with charm and elegance. Of average length, this wine is fresh and very plea-sant to drink.

Vine plots are located as follows: 2 ha along and near the Castle Troplong Mondot, 1 ha with the same exposure as the Château Pavie and 3 ha on the south facing slopes.
