

Tasting Notes

Beautiful bright and a rk garnet color with purple highlights. The nose is very expressive with aromas of ripe red and black fruits and spicy notes. The palate is sweet and harmonious. An intense sensation of ripe fruit and melted tannins complete the tasting. The terroir and knowhow of the entire Château team are fully expressed in this red wine, which is full of emotion



New facilities with temperature control, a half barrel cellar buried to maintain a constant humidity and a local water treatment for the waste were built in 2006 to meet the highest standards to produce and age a Grand Bordeaux worthy of its name.
